Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normal working hours and within 15 miles of George Hudson & Sons, 118 Wigton Road, Carlisle, CA2 7ES) into the funeral director's care.	<b>£120</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person may be kept at George Hudson & Sons 118 Wigton Rd. Carlisle, CA2 7ES	<b>£60</b>

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)

At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle with the necessary members of staff to conduct and the bearers.	<b>£300</b>

### Unattended Funeral

FEES YOU MUST PAY - see Additional Services

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

\* This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

\*\* In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
